The Confirmation Class is an opportunity for a seeker (confirmand) to explore, learn, and discover more about his or her beliefs, personal faith journey and faith community (Church).

As a member of the 2013 Immanuel Presbyterian Church Confirmation Class, I promise to faithfully fulfill the following covenant responsibilities.

- 1. Attend all confirmation classes and events to the best of my ability. If I must miss class or an event, I will inform, Chris, Pastor Aaron or Pastor Dan and understand I may be asked to do make-up assignments.
- 2. Demonstrate my allegiance to Jesus Christ and His Church by faithful attendance at worship on Sundays (or at other scheduled times).
- 3. As an act of personal devotion, to do the Bible reading assignments so that I may grow in my understanding of God's Word and more fully acquaint myself with the life, ministry, and teachings of Jesus.
- 4. Meet with my faith mentor at least once and fully participate in an open conversation with him/her about one's faith journey.

As a confirmand, I may expect the Church to faithfully fulfill these covenant responsibilities:

- 1. Offer well-prepared lesson plans in a variety of teaching approaches which stimulate and challenge the confirmand intellectually and foster greater appreciation for the Church and its mission.
- 2. Provide a positive atmosphere for learning in which questions, concerns and doubts can be freely expressed and discussed in a non judgmental manner.
- 3. Offer social opportunities during the program (lock-in, retreat, etc.) for fun and getting to know one another better.
- 4. Enable the confirmand to participate actively in the life and mission of Immanuel Church.
- 5. Provide an adult faith mentor who will journey with each confirmand through the confirmation process.
